- 1. The group leader should fill in each member's name, check all the required snow safety gear and documents in advance, and be responsible for the safety of all group members during the activity period. The leader and each member must also know how to operate and use all the snow safety gear and clothing.
- 2. <u>Items marked with an asterisk (\*) are especially important snow safety gear; the rest are recommended snow safety gear.</u> For regular snow climbing groups, if the group leader is absent, the entire group will have its entry permit revoked. If a group member does not meet the regulations, the risk will be on that individual or their group.
- 3. Rain boots and simple crampons are highly unrecommended. Step-in crampons only work with

- certain types of shoes, so please make sure your crampons and boots are compatible before starting a hike. It is recommended that hikers use standard certified safety helmets.
- 4. The snow training certificate must be issued by a legal registered institute, or group members must have proof of prior experience climbing well-known snowy terrain in Taiwan or overseas.

  Mountaineering guide certificates must be issued in accordance with provisions outlined in the "Mountaineering Guide Qualifications" by the Ministry of Education's Sport Administration.
